A mountain is an area of land over 300m high. Mountains are millions of years old. The biggest mountain ranges in the world are the European Alps. The Andes in South America, the Rockies in North America, and the Himalayas in Asia.

Different animals and plants live in different parts of a mountain. It is extremely cold and windy at the top of mountains and there is a lot of ice and snow. Also, there isn't much oxygen so no plants can grow there. Only a few insects can live in these conditions.

In the middle zone of a mountain, a lot of evergreen trees grow. They are called evergreen because they keep their leaves all year round. The conditions get easier there and more types of wild animals can survive, such as deer, wolves, hawks, bears, birds and wild cats.

At the bottom of the mountains, it is not so cold. Since the climate is not as extreme, many animals and plants live there, including trees which lose their leaves in winter. People also build towns and villages here.
